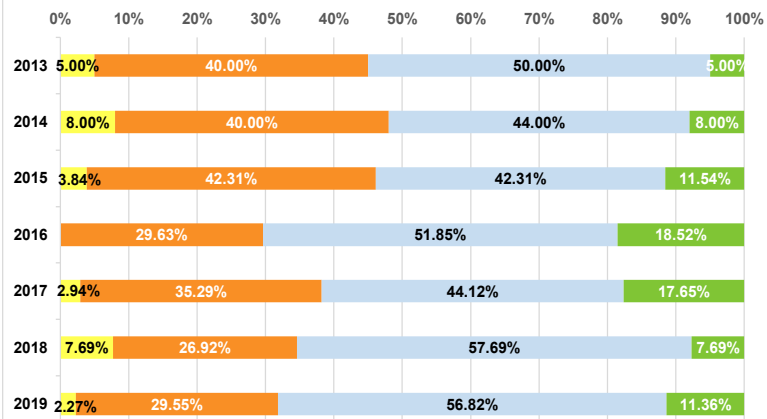
SCORE PERCENTAGES



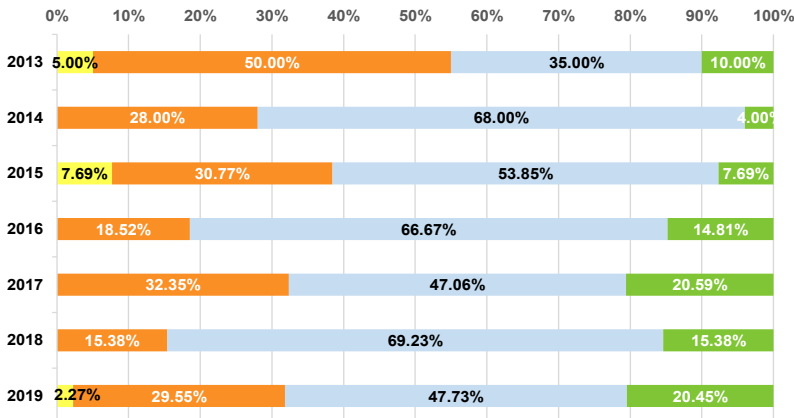
OVERALL SCORE AVERAGES



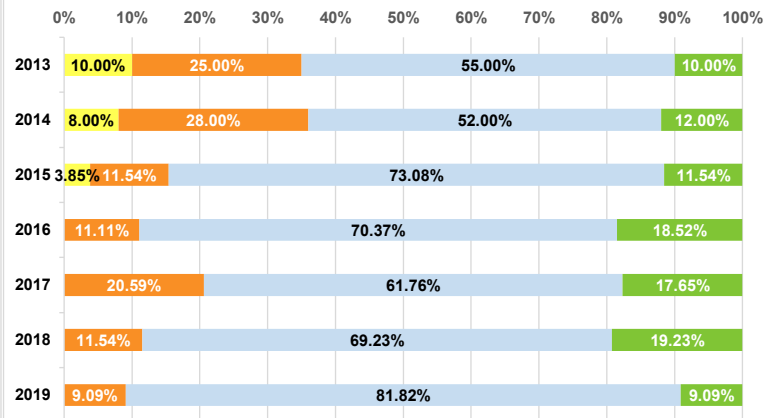

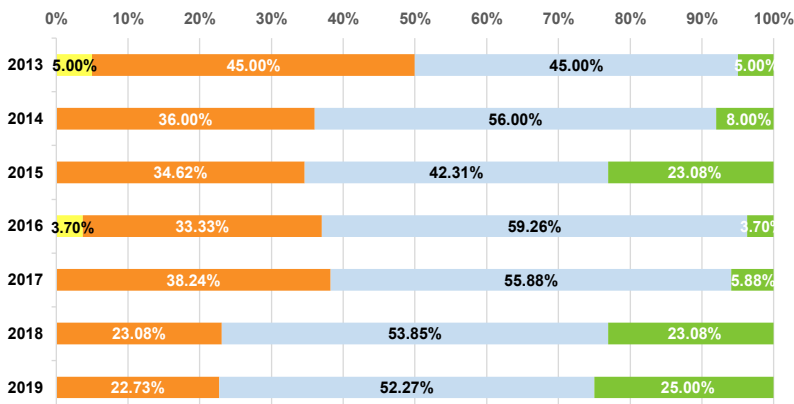
