

NASPA CONSORTIUM STUDY

The Office of Student Involvement participated in the 2015 NASPA Consortium Campus Activities study. A stratified random sample of students by classification (Fr, So, Jr, Sr) were invited to participate. Data was collected via an online survey in the spring of 2015, with 202 respondents. This reflects a 10% response rate. The following data points represent how **Auburn University** compares to the **national average**. The national average includes 16 participating colleges and universities.
