

# STUDENT AFFAIRS

## NOVEMBER 2017 UPDATE

Student Affairs at Auburn University has the responsibility for ensuring a true learning community committed to providing transformative educational experiences for all students, offering services to parents, and encouraging a culture of excellence at Auburn University.

### AUBURN CARES

Received 116 referrals in November 2017 compared to 92 referrals in November 2016, a **26% INCREASE**.

### AUBURN STUDENT MEDIA GROUP

Eagle Eye TV saw **14,940 PAGE VIEWS** on their website in November 2017.

### CAMPUS RECREATION

Intramurals **SERVED 4,072 UNIQUE STUDENTS** with 531 teams across 8 sports for fall 2017. This is up from 3,946 unique students with 378 teams across 6 sports in fall 2016.

### DEVELOPMENT

The office received a **\$10,000 GIFT** to support the Veterans Resource Center Executive Golf Camp Program.

### HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

Nutrition appointments are up 19% this fall with **299 APPOINTMENTS** compared to 252 appointments in fall 2016.

### MEDICAL CLINIC

Maintained a **4.9 OUT OF 5 AVERAGE** score for patient satisfaction when comparing survey results for November 2017 to November 2016.

### PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

The Family Portal averaged **2,295 WEEKLY POST VIEWS** during the month of November.

### PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

Safety and Health Technicians conducted a semi-annual inspection/certification of 72 Areas of Refuge devices with **98.6% PASSING**.

### STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

The International Student Organization hosted their annual Peace Dinner with over **1,400 STUDENTS** and community members attending compared to 1,200 attendees in 2016, a 16% increase.

### STUDENT CENTER OPERATIONS

The Student Center had **242,476 VISITORS** during November 2017 compared to 203,070 visitors in November 2016, a 19% increase.

### STUDENT CONDUCT

The office saw a **29% DECREASE** in the number of student referrals to the conduct table in the student section of Jordan-Hare Stadium in 2017 compared to 2016, with 86 referrals compared to 121.

### STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES

813 unique students were seen during November 2017 compared to 588 in November 2016, a **38% INCREASE**.

### UNIVERSITY HOUSING

Received **1,987 HOUSING APPLICATIONS** for fall 2018 compared to 1,352 for fall 2017, a 47% increase.

### VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER

The office saw 423 visitors in November 2017, up from 81 visitors in November 2016, a **422% INCREASE**.

### FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

**94 NEW ORIENTATION LEADERS** were hired for Camp War Eagle and Successfully Orienting Students.
