AUBURN CARES

The Critical Incident Response Team received 32 calls in September 2016, a 78 percent increase from September 2015.

CAMPUS RECREATION

DEVELOPMENT

In September, TESI, an alcohol education program for students, had over 100 student meetings, 64 of whom were new intakes.

There were 5,255 total patient visits in September 2016, a 3 percent increase from September 2015.

2,075 guests registered for Fall Family Weekend 2016.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

In September, Student Involvement had 767 students placed in involvement opportunities through application & interview processes.

The Student Center had 307,654 visitors in September 2016, a 47 percent increase from 2015.
