STUDENT AFFAIRS

#### AUBURN CARES

66 medical withdrawals were processed compared to 18 in November 2020, a 267% increase.

#### CAMPUS DINING

16 faculty, staff and graduate student meal plans, available for purchase at \$261.60 with a block of 30 meals, were sold. Eight of the meals plans were second-time purchases and one was a third-time purchase.

#### CAMPUS RECREATION

There were 48,606 access swipes into Campus Recreation.

#### FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

First Year Academic Initiatives offered three Ace That Class events, two new faculty panels geared to help students prepare for final exams, including a liberal arts panel with six attendees and a biology and chemistry panel with 32 attendees. Additionally, a registration assistance event was held to help students navigate Tiger Scheduler and provide support while registering for classes. There were 122 attendees compared to 44 from 2020.

#### GREEK LIFE

Over 800 students, alumni and guests attended National Pan-Hellenic Council's Tiger Stomp Step Show.

#### HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

95 nutrition service appointments were held compared to 75 in November 2020, a 27% increase.

#### MELTON STUDENT CENTER

84% of Melton Student Center banner poles were filled.

#### PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

122 contacts were added compared to 110 contacts in November 2020, an 11% increase.

#### PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

There was a 17% decrease in work orders with 352 compared to November 2020 with 424. It took an average of one and a half days to complete work orders.

#### STUDENT CONDUCT

During the 2021 football season, 130 students were referred to the Student Conduct table. This is a 1,344% increase from 2020 with 9 alcohol referrals, a 319% increase from 2019 with 31 referrals and is 7% higher than the all-time high in 2016 with 121 referrals.

#### STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,224 unique students were seen.

#### STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

352,389 pounds of food was collected during the Beat Bama Food Drive for the Food Bank of East Alabama compared to 259,160 pounds in 2020, a 36% increase. Beat Bama Food Drive broke the record for most pounds of food collected by Auburn in the history of the drive.

#### UNIVERSITY HOUSING

As of Dec. 1, 1,719 new applications for fall 2022 have been received compared to 659 during December 2020, and 764 returning student applications for fall 2022 have been received compared to 390 during December 2020.
