STUDENT AFFAIRS

AUBURN CARES

102 referrals were received, a 59% increase compared to 64 in January 2021.

CAMPUS DINING

\$12,839 dining dollars were spent by students at the No. 2 Auburn vs. No. 12 Kentucky men's basketball game compared to \$6,058.68 spent in January 2021 when both teams were unranked.

CAMPUS RECREATION

137 items were rented from Auburn Outdoors for Jungle Village before the Auburn vs. Kentucky men's basketball game. This the most items rented in one day.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

91 students were enrolled in six sections of UNIV 1060: Success Strategies II for spring 2022, an 111% increase compared to spring 2021. The increase is likely from a change in marketing strategy and availability of in-person classes.

GREEK LIFE

774 events were hosted in fall 2021.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

The Wellness Coaching program welcomed two new coaches to the spring 2022 team.

MEDICAL CLINIC

5,249 patients visited the Med Clinic, a 4% increase from January 2021. 2,023 of the visits were COVID-19 tests.

MELTON STUDENT CENTER

Student Center Reservations saw an 11% increase in reservations from January 2021 to January 2022.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

Family Portal content had an open rate of 60% from January 2021 to January 2022, which is up 56% from January 2020 to January 2021.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

575 work orders were received compared to 655 in January 2021, a 12% decrease. These orders were a total of 504 labor hours and an average of two days each to complete the work.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Addressed 231 student conduct cases in fall 2021 compared to 216 in fall 2020, a 7% increase.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,074 unique students were seen compared to 813 in January 2021, a 32% increase.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

The Black Student Union and Alternative Student Breaks hosted MLK Day of Service and took 43 students and six staff members to Selma, Alabama.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

Received 3,447 new applications for fall 2022.
