AUBURN CARES

The Campus Food Pantry had **99** visits in October 2019, a **17.9 increase** from 84 visits in October 2018.

CAMPUS DINING

Tiger Dining received **415** pounds of tilapia filets, **442** pounds of cucumbers, **84.6** pounds of bell peppers, **78** pounds of tomatoes and **315** heads of lettuce from the Aquaponics Project for use in campus dining locations.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Campus Recreation welcomed **219** potential student employee applicants to its fall job fair RECxpo, a **21% increase** from the spring 2019 event.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

209 incoming spring transfer students have completed the new online pre-orientation modules ahead of the registration time tickets opening. These modules helped facilitate communication with their academic advisors so they could register for classes before attending orientation.

GREEK LIFE

17 out of 18 Panhellenic sororities have completed initiation as of October 2019, representing 1,392 new members joining the Panhellenic community. This reflects that approximately 97% of the women who received bids this semester have affiliated with their organizations.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

According to the McBee Campus Climate Survey, **32%** of survey respondents reported they had been trained in Green Dot, a **9.4% increase** from 2017.

MEDIA & MARKETING

The Auburn Plainsman's website saw **224,027** page views during October 2019, a **12.8% increase** from the 198,665 views in October 2018.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The Medical Clinic had **6,081** patient visits in October 2019, a **10.6% increase** from 5,498 patient visits in October 2018.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

The Family Portal had **23,640** parent users as of October 2019, a **19.4% increase** from 19,802 users in October 2018.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Property Management processed **681** housing and dining work requests in October 2019, a **10.6% increase** from 616 orders processed in October 2018.

STUDENT CENTER

55.9% of all bookings in October 2019 were theater–style, a **6% increase** from 49.9% in October 2018.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Student Conduct had **16** students referred for policy issues inside Jordan–Hare Stadium through four games in 2019, a **65.2% decrease** from 46 students referred in 2018.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

SCPS saw **1,025** unique students in October 2019, a **25.9% increase** from 814 unique students seen in October 2018.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

484 unique students volunteered with IMPACT, serving a total of 1,946 service hours in October 2019, a 16.3% increase from 1,673 service hours in October 2018.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

University Housing completed **65** incident reports during October 2019, a **32.9% decrease** from 97 reports completed in October 2018.
