DEPARTMENT DATA POINTS AUGUST 2019

AUBURN CARES

Auburn Cares conducted **10** outreach presentations in August 2019, a **100% increase** from August 2018.

CAMPUS DINING

Phase One of renovations to Village Dining concluded in August 2019, featuring **eight new** dining concepts and a Chick-fil-a.

CAMPUS RECREATION

As a result of implementing the FusionGO app in fall 2018, Campus Recreation saw an **85% decrease** in forgotten IDs in summer 2019 versus summer 2018.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

33.1% (1,585) of the incoming freshman class elected to take a First Year Seminar in fall 2019, a **1.4% increase** from the fall 2018 semester.

GREEK LIFE

The Panhellenic Recruitment match rate for 2019 was **89.87%**, a **1.4% increase** from 2018 Recruitment.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

96% of first–year students and **48%** of transfer students completed the AlphaPoint education program, respectively, a **2%** and **17% increase** from 2018.

MEDIA & MARKETING

Eagle Eye TV's website saw **63,892** page views during summer 2019 compared to 25,677 in summer 2018, a **148.8% increase**.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The Medical Clinic had **3,715** patient visits in August 2019, a **10.1% increase** from the 3,374 patients seen in August 2018.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

There are **23,336** registered members of the Auburn University Parent & Family Association, a **19.1% increase** from 19,590 members in August 2018.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

1,133 housing and dining projects were successfully completed in August 2019, a **9.78%** increase from August 2018.

STUDENT CENTER

As a part of a permanent room set-up pilot, Room 2017 saw an increase in usage of **18.7%** between August 2018 and August 2019.

STUDENT CONDUCT

In a pre/post assessment conducted by Student Conduct, **99.6%** of students who attended a meeting with their department in academic year 2018–2019 agreed the meeting(s) "helped them better understand their rights and responsibilities as a member of the Auburn community," a **1.5%** increase from academic year 2017–2018.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,009 individual and group sessions were conducted in August 2019, a **54% increase** from 655 individual, emergency and group sessions in August 2018.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

4,382 students attended Convocation, coordinated by Student Involvement. **89%** of the freshman class were in attendance, a **6% increase** from fall 2018.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

University Housing welcomed **4,088** students to campus over the course of three move–in days.
