Student Affairs at Auburn University has the responsibility for ensuring a true learning community committed to providing transformative educational experiences for all students, offering services to parents, and encouraging a culture of excellence at Auburn University.

AUBURN CARES

The Campus Food Pantry received 10,000 DRY MEALS from the organization Feeding Children Everywhere.

AUBURN STUDENT MEDIA GROUP

WEGL 91.1 FM saw **1,238 TOTAL LISTENING HOURS** in January 2018 compared to 1,068 hours in January 2017, a 16% increase.

CAMPUS DINING

Amsterdam was the most popular food truck during the month of January, **SELLING 1,074 TURKEY WRAPS**.

DEVELOPMENT

The office saw a \$25,000 GIFT contributed to an endowed scholarship.

GREEK LIFE

The all-Greek GPA for fall 2017 was 3.282, compared to 3.223 for the spring 2017 semester.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

In the month of January 2018 nutrition hosted 52 appointments compared to 29 in January 2017, a 79% INCREASE.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The average score of the Patient Satisfaction Survey for January 2018 was a **4.9 OUT OF 5.**

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SERVICES

RESTORED 21 RESIDENTIAL SUITES heavily damaged by flooding incidents during the holiday break, allowing displaced residents to return to their homes in a timely manner.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

Service Programs hosted a 3-day blood drive with the American Red Cross collecting **376 UNITS OF BLOOD**, a 15.3% increase from the January 2017 drive.

STUDENT CENTER OPERATIONS

The Student Center had 475 ROOM RESERVATIONS in January 2018 compared to 456 room reservations in January 2017, a 4.2% increase.

STUDENT CONDUCT

96.5% (284 OUT OF 294) of students who participated in a meeting with a conduct officer in the academic year 2017-2018 agreed that it was educational.

STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES

1,117 individual, emergency and group sessions were conducted in January 2018 compared to 934 in January 2017, A 19.6% INCREASE.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

In the month of January, Resident Assistants submitted 91 Incident Reports, hosted 51 programs, and completed **74 BULLETIN BOARDS.**

VETERANS RESOURCE CENTER

The office saw **577 VISITORS IN JANUARY** 2018 compared to 349 visitors in January 2017, a 65% increase.
