STUDENT AFFAIRS

Student Affairs at Auburn University houses 14 departments that have the responsibility for ensuring a true learning community committed to providing transformative educational experiences for all students, offering services to parents, and encouraging a culture of excellence at Auburn University.

AUBURN STUDENT MEDIA GROUP

The 2016 welcome back edition for *The Auburn Plainsman* increased revenue by 62 percent compared to the 2015 edition.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Total participation in group fitness classes in August 2016 increased by 72 percent from 2015.

DEVELOPMENT

The office had six new families join the Parent Development Board.

GREEK LIFE

On Sept. 1, National Pan-Hellenic Council held the Unity Yardshow Event, a showcase of individual organizations' songs, dances, strolls and steps. With over 250 attendees, this was the best-attended Yardshow yet.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

The Be Well Hut, a student-to-student education program, had interaction with over 1,000 students during its first week of operation in August.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The Medical Clinic had an overall patient satisfaction rating of 4.9 out of 5 in August.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

The 2016 welcome back event, Home Sweet Auburn, was a success with a 71 percent increase in attendance from the 2015 event.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

In August, the AUinvolve website had 45,402 unique sessions, a 41 percent increase from August 2015.

STUDENT CENTER

The Student Center had 385,064 visitors during May, June, July and August 2016 compared to 213,971 for the same period in 2015.

STUDENT CONDUCT

In a survey by the Office of Student Conduct, 100 percent of respondents said they agreed or strongly agreed to the statements "All of my questions were answered during the conduct process" and "I felt respected by my conduct officer."

STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES

SCS conducted 801 individual, emergency and group sessions in August.

VETERANS AFFAIRS

Over 911 student veterans, spouses, and dependents were properly certified and processed by Veterans Resource Center staff in order to begin the 2016–2017 Auburn University academic school year.

AWARDS

BILLY FERRIS, advisor for Auburn Student Media Group, received the Undergraduate Teaching Excellence Award, presented by the Alumni Association to three professors each year, for his work as an adjunct professor in the School of Communications and Journalism.
