Safe Harbor, a sexual assault advocacy program, received 100% satisfaction rates from clients in a 2015 satisfaction study.

STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES

Student Counseling Services performed 28 group therapy sessions in March.

Development secured 50% more funds than last month with \$50,000 for an Endowed Excellence Scholarship & \$75,000 for an endowed fund for Leadership Programs.
