### CASE MANAGEMENT & STUDENT ADVOCACY

The Office of Case Management & Student Advocacy held the annual Fall Food Drive in partnership with Greek Life with more than two truckloads of non-perishable foods collected.

# STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES

The office saw 503 unique students during September. 1,045 individual, emergency and group sessions were conducted.

On September 16, 28 staff and faculty members participated in training to serve as QPR facilitators for suicide prevention.

There has been 14.7 percent increase in the purchase of group fitness passes compared to fall semester 2014.

The Student Center had 209,077 visitors and 542 room reservations during September.
