AUBURN CARES

The Campus Food Pantry had **72** visits in September 2019, a **10.8% increase** from 65 visits in September 2018.

CAMPUS DINING

During September, Campus Dining supported the fight against food insecurity by donating unserved food to the **AU Campus Kitchens Project**. Campus Kitchens used these donations to serve **348 meals** to Auburn students.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Campus Recreation saw an **86.7% increase** in participation for **Ladies Night** at the climbing wall between September 2018 and September 2019.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

First Year Academic Initiatives continued hosting its inaugural year of the expanded **"Ace That..."** series of workshops aimed at helping first-year students adjust to college life and academics. Topics for September included taking notes, getting organized and exam recovery.

GREEK LIFE

The National Pan–Hellenic Council (NPHC) hosted its **Tiger Stomp Step Show**, grossing **\$5,242.03** in presale tickets. The money will be donated to support the NPHC Legacy Plaza.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

HPWS facilitated a workshop for all new Panhellenic members in September 2019 to educate students about the signs and symptoms of alcohol overdoses and to promote proactive bystander behaviors. As a result of the workshop, surveyed new Panhellenic members responding that bluish skin color is "definitely" or "probably" a sign of alcohol poisoning increased from **79.1% to 97%**.

MEDIA & MARKETING

The Circle received **278 submissions** for its fall 2019 issue, a **5.3% increase** from 264 submissions for their fall 2018 issue.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The Medical Clinic had **5,606 patient** visits in September 2019, an **8% increase** from 5,189 pa-tient visits in September 2018.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

2,998 guests attended the Auburn Parent & Family Association's Fall Family Weekend Tailgate, a **2.3% increase** from 2,932 attendees in fall 2018.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Property Management processed **632 housing work orders** in September 2019, a **33.3% increase** from 474 housing work orders processed in September 2018.

STUDENT CENTER

Student Center Reservations saw a **61.2% increase** in **advertising space** usage between September 2018 and September 2019.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Student Conduct saw a **64.3% decrease** in the total number of students referred for **policy issues inside Jordan-Hare stadium** between September 2018 and September 2019.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

Student Counseling & Psychological Services saw **850 unique students** in September 2019, a **.7% increase** from 844 students seen in September 2018.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

SGA collected **10,203 votes** for **Miss Homecoming elections**, the most votes ever cast in the Miss Homecoming election history.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

Official fall 2019 occupancy is at **97.2%**, a **.8% increase** from 96.4% in fall 2018.
