AUBURN CARES

Received **15** medical withdrawal applications in September 2020 (began handling all medical withdrawals in spring/summer 2020).

CAMPUS DINING

Initiated a food delivery service through Grubhub for students who live in campus housing. Delivered **105** meals in the first month to campus residents.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Olympic/Powerlifting reservations for September 2020 totaled **267**, this is a **23%** increase from 217 reservations in September 2019.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

Hosted a new Ace That Class faculty panel titled "Professors are People, Too!" Next year it will be held during Camp War Eagle to increase its reach and help incoming students set expectations for their interactions with professors before arriving on campus.

GREEK LIFE

Auburn Greek Programing Board supported National Hazing Prevention Week (NHPW). Resources to help end hazing were shared across social media platforms and reached a total of **9,769** students across three days of campaigns focused on Recognize It (3,804); Report It (3,293); and End It (2,672).

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

Mental Health Training Day had 234 participants. HPWS trained 79 people in QPR, 88 in Active Minds' VAR Training, and 67 attended the "A Sound Mind" Overview. Once trained in VAR, 93% of participants could identify a VAR statement.

MEDICAL CLINIC

The clinic received **5,096** patient visits for September 2020, which is a 9.1% decrease from 5,606 patient visits for September 2019.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

In lieu of Fall Family Weekend, Parent & Family Programs provided 25 Fall Family Activities for parents and families. More information about Fall Family Activities can be found at aub.ie/ffa2020

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Completed **525** work orders during the month of September 2020; the top three work order repair categories were Plumbing (83), Electrical (67), and Dining Equipment (54).

STUDENT CENTER

73.8% of room set-ups were theater style in September 2020 compared to 53.0% in September 2019, a 39.2% increase.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Operated **two** football game day tables for the first time ever during September 2020. **Thirteen** volunteers spent **six** hours supporting game day operations, including encouraging students to comply with COVID-19 procedures during the Kentucky game.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,671 individual and group sessions were conducted during the month of September 2020; a 0.4% increase compared to 1,665 individual and group sessions conducted in September 2019.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

950 student organization in–person and virtual events, meetings and activities were submitted to AUinvolve during the month of September 2020. The Glomerata had **1,654** website pageviews in September 2020 compared to 456 in September 2019, a 262.7% increase.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

As of the 15th class day for the fall 2020 semester, Auburn University Housing's occupancy rate was **96.5%**. Compared to fall 2019 (97.2%), the occupancy rate decreased by 0.7% overall.
