 - Discussed:
 - COVID related operations
 - Numbers frequently change
 - COVID 19
 - Move out & move in practices changed
 - Training changed
 - Addition of 160 Ross
 - New needs; combat drinking culture
 - Number 1 Priority: Quarantine and Isolation Housing
 - Creating proper feedback processes
 - NASPA information
 - Abby praised how it was laid out
 - Working on move in surveys

- 90% satisfaction rate; up 7.55%
- Torey Palmer: Wonder what was not being met in move in survey?
 - Not having movers to help move in
 - Signage
- Quarantine/Isolation Housing
 - Total occupancy 67%
