#### **ASSESSMENT & STRATEGIC PLANNING**

Three <u>Assessment Curriculum Training</u> sessions were held with 16 Student Affairs staff participants. AU Planning & Outcome Writing (9), Outside-the-Box Methods (3) and Dashboards (4).

#### **AUBURN CARES**

179 student referrals were received, a 40% increase compared to March 2020. 44 medical withdrawal applications were received, 21 medical withdrawals were processed and one outreach presentation was conducted.

#### **CAMPUS DINING**

Introduced <u>new meal plans</u> and began preparations for sharing with the student body <u>The Edge</u>, Central Dining's <u>all you care to eat dining hall</u>.

#### **CAMPUS RECREATION**

Competitive sports had 1,538 individuals participate in <u>club activities</u> and 1,454 participate in <u>intramurals</u>.

#### DEVELOPMENT

Received over \$76,000 in leadership scholarship funds and a \$50,000 commitment to the <u>Auburn Campus</u> Recovery Community.

#### FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

153 students and 74 guests participated in a virtual transfer orientation program, <u>Successfully Orienting</u> Students.

#### **GREEK LIFE**

Greek Officer Advancement Training, or GOAT, was presented virtually and had 1,177 views of the content across 174 interactions.

## HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

Mental Health Training Day was held with a total of 157 participants, including 46.3% undergraduate students, 34.3% staff members, 13.4% graduate students and 6% faculty members. There was an average of 17 participants per training.

#### MEDICAL CLINIC

The clinic had 4,182 patients with 1,273 of those visits being for COVID-19 tests, including rapid antigen, rapid molecular and PCR tests. 152 antibody tests were performed. This is a 77.1% increase from patient visits in March 2020.

#### MELTON STUDENT CENTER

162 meeting room reservations were made with 34.6% of meeting room setups being theatre style and 38.9% setups being created by the groups in the space.

#### **PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS**

10 honorees were selected to receive the Auburn University <u>Parent & Family Association's Faculty and Staff</u> Award.

#### PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Property Management completed 534 works orders, a 122.5% increase from March 2020.

#### STUDENT CONDUCT

Conducted the sixth annual <u>Be the Creed campaign</u> and recognized <u>26</u> Be the Creed nominees, a <u>136.4%</u> increase from 2020. Students were nominated by faculty, staff and students for exemplifying the different facets of the Auburn Creed.

### STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

Conducted 2,321 individual and group sessions, saw 1,085 clients, held 54 psychiatric evaluations and completed 316 follow-up appointments.

#### STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

<u>The BIG Event</u> hosted 550 student volunteers at 140 job sites in the Auburn/Opelika area, completing nearly 2,000 hours of service.

#### UNIVERSITY HOUSING

2,549 new students selected a room assignment, which is a 24% increase from the new students who selected room assignments in March 2020.
