Torey shared departmental presentation about Parent & Family Programs

- Discussed bottleneck issues that arise with having an office of one.
- Looking at data longitudinally (2014-2021), experiencing a 10% increase year to year for contact points (email and phone) with parents and family. Currently at a 60% increase in contact points from pre-Covid to now.
- Presented graphs to visually represent changes, broke down contact data by month, topic, and method (email vs. call).
- Discussed Family Portal year to year growth from 2010-2021 and how presenting data helped on campus relationships between Admissions and PFP office.
- Utilized contact data for evidence and justification of requesting an additional personnel staff member within Student Affairs.

Amy Mosley shared about the tool called "Flow-e" (<u>https://flow-e.com/</u>) to create a visual task board to categorize and organize email topics.
