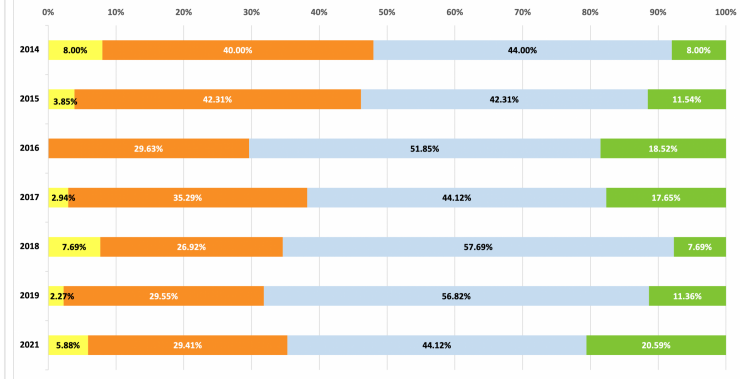
### SCORE PERCENTAGES



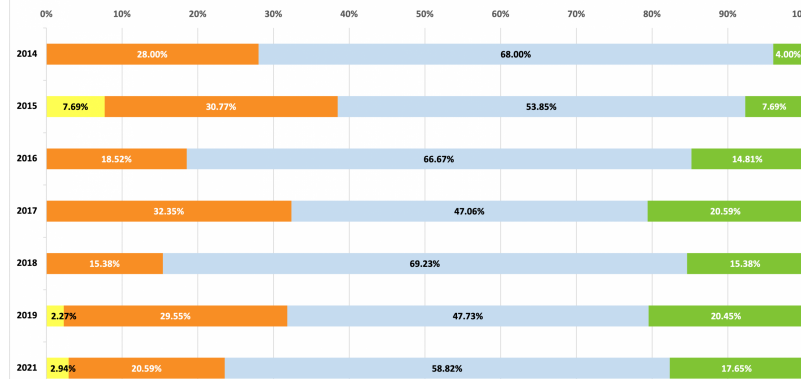
### OVERALL SCORE AVERAGES



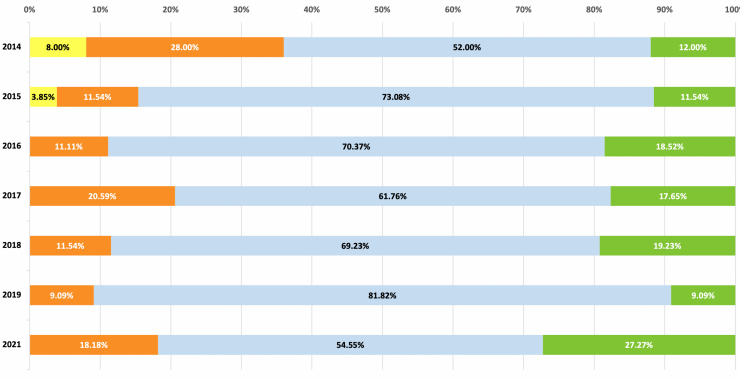

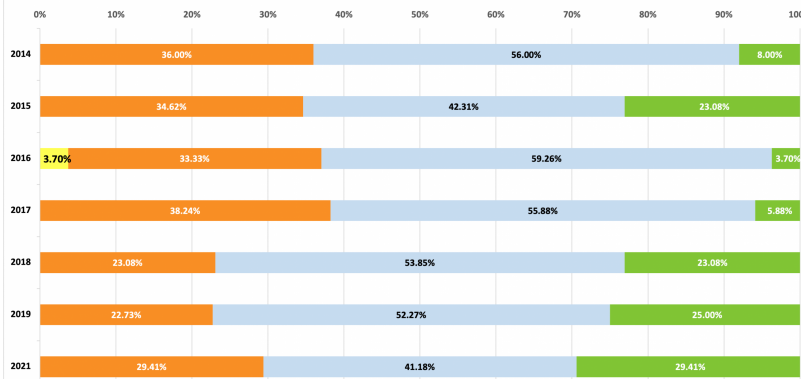
