ASSESSMENT & STRATEGIC PLANNING

Awarded 17 Assessment Curriculum certificates to staff members who completed all Tier I-Foundational (9), Tier II-Intermediate (4), and/or Tier III-Advanced (4) trainings for the 2020-2021 academic year.

AUBURN CARES

155 referrals were received, compared to 81 referrals in August 2020.

CAMPUS DINING

Tiger Dining opened The Edge, an 800+ seat dining hall, to students on Aug. 9.

CAMPUS RECREATION

During the first week of class, there were 18,071 card swipes for entry into the Recreation and Wellness Center. Of those swipes, 7,054 were distinct users.

DEVELOPMENT

\$1,292,963 was raised in fiscal year 2021—the most in Auburn Student Affairs history when excluding planned gifts.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

Academic Initiatives successfully recruited 1,360 students into First Year Seminars and Learning Communities during the spring semester and at Camp War Eagle. 61% of students enrolled in a Themed First Year Seminar or Learning Community, 32% of students enrolled in Success Strategies and 7% of students enrolled in a Residential Learning Community, which are all comparable to enrollment during the 2020-2021 academic year.

GREEK LIFE

National Panhellenic Council gave out 1,690 bids, an all-time university record.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

The Alcohol and Drug Prevention team had 16 appointments with 15 students in August, compared to 45 appointments with 28 students in August 2020.

MELTON STUDENT CENTER

Student Center Reservations held 1,317 events in August, a 25% increase compared to 1,057 events in August 2020.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

6,433 new parents and families were imported into the Family Portal for the 2021-2022 academic year.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Completed 1,013 work orders in August, a 12% decease compared to the 1,151 work orders serviced in August 2020. The top three work orders were plumbing (135), electrical (123) and doors (101). The top three residence hall buildings with requests were Cambridge (93), South Donahue (80) and Aubie Hall (64), and the top three campus dining buildings with requests were Village View Dining (44), Terrell Dining (23) and Wellness Kitchen (13).

STUDENT CONDUCT

Completed no organization investigations during August, down from 6 investigations in August 2020. This is the fewest number of investigations since 2013.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

855 unique students were seen during August compared to 616 unique students seen during August 2020, a 39% increase.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

Through Mobile Check-In, 9,773 students attended 563 organization events in August.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

Welcomed 4.563 students for fall 2021.
