ASSESSMENT & STRATEGIC PLANNING

Undergraduate students who completed degrees during 2019-2020 were emailed six months after graduation a brief survey on their employment plans post-graduation. Students who responded reported having accepted full-time employment at a rate of 49% compared to surveyed students in the Emerge leadership program who reported higher rates of having accepted full-time employment at 55%.

AUBURN CARES

237 referrals were received, compared to 119 referrals in September 2020.

CAMPUS DINING

105 pounds of produce from the Community Garden was donated to Campus Kitchen projects.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Competitive Sports expanded its partnership with students to add its 28th club sport, softball.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

First Year Seminars and Learning Communities sent an interest survey to all Residential Learning Community, or RLC, and Learning Community, or LC, students. These students had the opportunity to opt into pre-registration for core classes associated with the theme of their RLC or LC with 394 out of 556 students responding that they want to continue in a learning community in the spring.

GREEK LIFE

The Multicultural Greek Council Instagram account interaction increased by 183% with 828 accounts reached compared to 293 accounts reached in August 2021.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

Hosted 26 outreach presentations that reached 2,988 students.

MELTON STUDENT CENTER

Student Center Reservations saw a 40% increase in events with 1,707 bookings compared to 1,223 bookings in September 2020.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

There were 3,487 registered guests for the Fall Family Weekend 2021 tailgate, which is a 16% increase from 2019 with 2,999 guests.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

There was an 18% increase in work orders with 610 compared to September 2020 with 519.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Through the first three home football games, 74 students were referred to the Student Conduct table. This is up 1,380% from 2020 with five alcohol referrals, up 393% from 2019 with 15 alcohol referrals and up 76% from 2018, with 42 alcohol referrals.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

2,003 individual and group appointments were conducted, a 20% increase compared to 1,671 individual and group sessions conducted in September 2020.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

IMPACT hosted 173 projects with 1,087 registered volunteers completing 2,174 hours of service.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

As of the 15th class day for the fall semester, the occupancy rate is 99%. Compared to fall 2020, the occupancy rate increased by 2%. Cambridge Hall increased by 2%, The Hill increased by 3%, The Quad increased by 2%, The Village increased by .7%, South Donahue increased by 2% and 160 Ross increased by 6%.
