AUBURN CARES

62 medical withdrawal applications were received, compared to 37 applications in October 2020, a 68% increase.

CAMPUS DINING

55,434 meal swipes were used at The Edge at Central Dining in October.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Intramural sports hosted Flag Football Championship Night, and champions were named in Men's Independent, Small Fraternity, Large Fraternity and Sorority divisions. There were 1,200 students and fans in attendance.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

Posted 13 posts on the Academic Initiative, or AI, Instagram, with a reach of 2,956 accounts, compared to seven posts that reached 839 accounts in October 2020. Reach improved as AI encouraged peer instructors to promote the AI Instagram account in seminar courses, as well as when First Year Experience collaborated with other offices and departments.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

There were 20 completed outreach presentations, reaching 1,200 students in October.

MELTON STUDENT CENTER

Student Center Reservations saw a 40% increase in events compared to October 2020.

PARENT & FAMILY PROGRAMS

There were 34,237 parent users, a 13% increase, in the Family Portal compared to October 2020 with 30,192 users.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

There was a 2% increase in work orders with 624 compared to September 2021 with 610. The top five buildings with worker orders were The Edge (41), South Donahue Residence Hall (41), Sasnett Residence Hall (39), Aubie Residence Hall (36) and Village View Dining (36). The top five problem code request were environmental (103), plumbing fixtures (82), electrical (69), dining equipment (61) and general maintenance (39).

STUDENT CONDUCT

Through the first five home football games, 118 students were referred to the Student Conduct table. This is up 1,211% from 2020 with nine alcohol referrals, up 462% from 2019 with 21 alcohol referrals and up 23% from the previous all-time high in 2016 with 96 referrals.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,290 unique students were seen, a 34% increase from 966 in October 2020.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

Student Government Association distributed 11,275 name tags on Hey Day.

UNIVERSITY HOUSING

To date, in fall 2021, University Housing has facilitated 393 residential programs to support and engage students on campus. Of those programs, 63 were collaborative events with campus partners.
