AUBURN CARES

The Campus Food Pantry had 35 new users compared to seven new users in February 2021.

CAMPUS DINING

36 Faculty/Staff/Graduate Student Meal Plans were sold. This is the second largest amount sold since the meal plans were offered for purchase in August 2021. The meal plans include a block of 30 meals for \$261.60 and are available for purchase.

CAMPUS RECREATION

Facilities saw a 13% increase in distinct users from January 2022 with 10,916 users to February 2022 with 12,285 users.

DEVELOPMENT

\$91,040 was raised on Tiger Giving Day from 1,031 donors. For the first time, Student Affairs had seven projects including the ISHA Equestrian Team, the Auburn Bass Fishing Team, Auburn Esports, Campus Food Pantry, Wheelchair Basketball, Baby Steps at Auburn and the Veterans Resource Center. The average donation ranged from \$39.15 to \$141.11.

FIRST YEAR EXPERIENCE

Orientation Programs partnered with over 50 campus departments to organize Tiger Transitions, a 148 page guidebook. It is estimated 13,500 copies will be distributed to incoming freshmen, transfers and their families through Camp War Eagle and SOS this year.

GREEK LIFE

The all-Greek fall 2021 GPA average of 3.31 was 0.12 higher than the all-undergraduate average GPA of 3.19.

HEALTH PROMOTION & WELLNESS SERVICES

The nutrition team raised \$3,890 through the National Eating Disorder Association walking event.

MEDICAL CLINIC

3,810 patients visited the Med Clinic with 347 of those visits being for COVID-19 tests, including rapid antigen and PCR tests. This is a 12% decrease from February 2021.

MELTON STUDENT CENTER

15% of customers who made reservations had unique setups created specifically for their events compared to 4% in February 2021.

PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

457 work orders were completed taking 402.53 hours and an average of 1.24 days to complete compared to 566 work orders taking 602.5 hours and 6.38 days to complete in February 2021.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Trained 31 faculty, staff and students to serve as third party investigators during the upcoming calendar year. Over the past four years, 175 investigators have been trained.

STUDENT COUNSELING & PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

1,259 unique students were seen compared to 1,036 in February 2021, a 22% increase.

STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

The Black Student Union hosted 10 events with a total of 796 attendees for Black History Month compared to seven events and 346 attendees in 2021.
