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- The Campus Food Pantry had 132 new users for February 2023, compared to 35 new users during February 2022, a 277.14% increase.
- Received 158 referrals to the Auburn Cares office in February 2023, compared to 153 referrals during February 2022, a 3.26% increase.
- The Auburn Cares office received 25 medical withdrawal applications in February 2023, compared to 38 applications in February 2022, a 26.92% decrease.
- The Auburn Cares office processed 27 medical withdrawals during February 2023, compared to 33 processed in Feb 2022, an 18.18% decrease.
- The Auburn Cares office conducted 9 outreach presentations, compared to 7 in February 2022, a 28.57% increase.
- The Campus Food Pantry had 1085 visits, compared to 141 in February 2022, a 669.50% increase.
- Twenty-three (23) survivors utilized Safe Harbor Services in the month of February, compared to 9 in February 2022, a 155.56% increase.

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- Campus Recreation facilities saw a decline in distinct users in February 2023 (11,347) compared to February 2022 (12,285), a 7.64% decrease, but a consistent number of swipes into the facilities (74,154 in 2022 compared to 74,119 in 2023), a 0.05% decrease.
- While the Campus Recreation and Wellness Center declined 1% in swipes, the SportsPlex saw a 29% increase in 2023 swipes into the facility (5,151) compared to 2022 (4,004).
- Intramural Sports forfeit rate (team no show) rate dropped by 50% from February 2022
