- The Campus Food Pantry had 149 new users for January 2023, compared to 9 new users during January 2022, a 1,555.56% increase.
- Received 39 medical withdrawal applications in January 2023, compared to 47 applications in January 2022, 20.51% increase.
- Processed 32 medical withdrawals during January 2023, compared to 21 in January 2022, a 52.38% increase.
- Conducted 0 outreach presentations, compared to 2 during January 2022, a 100% decrease.
- The Campus Food Pantry had 637 visits, compared to 45 in January 2022, a 1,315.56% increase.
- 19 survivors utilized Safe Harbor Services in the month of January, compared to 6 in January 2022, a 216.76% increase.

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

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- The January 2023 revenue at both Chick-fil-A locations on campus was 20.49 % of all January 2023 dining revenue. In January 2022, the revenue at both Chick-fil-A locations was 23.24% of all dining revenue during that time period. This is an 11.83% decrease.
- 66,062 meal swipes were used at The Edge and Tiger Zone during January 2023, compared to 50,346 meal swipes at The Edge and Tiger Zone in January 2022, a 31.22% increase.
- "Mexican Fiesta" was held on January 17, 2023 at The Edge. 1,581 participants attended this lunch time Mexican themed meal.

- Campus Recreation had 871 non-student memberships in January 2023, compared to 773 in January 2022, a 12.68% increase.
