- Processed 57 medical withdrawals during November 2022, compared to 66 in November 2020, a 13.64% decrease.

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- Orientation Programs selected 66 Orientation Counselors to facilitate Camp War Eagle and Successfully Orienting Students sessions. This is a change from previous years, which had a team of students working with each program individually. After examining the needs of incoming transfer students, freshmen, and their guests, we decided that we consolidating into one team would allow FYE to better serve these populations.
- First Year Academic Initiatives offered three Ace That Class events in November. We offered two faculty panels to help students prepare for final exams: a Liberal Arts panel and a STEM Panel. We had 2 and 5 attendees respectively which is down from last year. We attribute the decrease with the timing of the events being before Thanksgiving Break. Finally, we offered a registration assistance event to help student navigate Tiger Scheduler and provide support while they registered for classes. We had 120 attendees come over the course of the day which is on par with last year's numbers.
