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- MOVE: Fall Fitness on the Green Space (presented by Group Fitness) had a record high of 99 participants on October 10, 2022, compared to 30 participants in October 2021, a 230% increase.
- 51% (12,890 students) of the undergraduate population has accessed at least one Campus Recreation facility or program since August 9, 2022. 4,307 freshmen, 3,078 sophomores, 2,533 juniors, and 2,972 seniors.
- 160 participants attended Oar's and S'mores presented by Auburn Outdoors on October 26, 2022. The event was held on the Campus Green with music, s'mores, coffee, cocoa, and pumpkin painting.

- Academic Initiatives recruited 1,330 students (around 25% of the incoming freshman class) into First Year Seminars and Learning Communities. 57% of students were enrolled in a Themed First Year Seminars/Learning Communities, 35% in UNIV1050: Success Strategies, and 8% in Residential Learning communities. These numbers are comparable to last year.
- Orientation Programs hosted 11 in person sessions and 3 virtual sessions of Camp War Eagle (CWE) as well as 7 in person sessions and 4 virtual sessions of Successfully Orienting Students SOS. CWE oriented 5,276 Freshman and their 5,928 guests. SOS oriented 1,416 transfer students and their 647 guests. Orientation programs served 13,267 people, which is a 21% increase from last year.
