- Received 197 referrals to the Auburn Cares office in April 2023, compared to 135 referrals during April 2022, a 45.93% increase.
- Received 64 medical withdrawal applications in April 2023, compared to 54 applications in April 2022, an 18.52% increase.
- Processed 47 medical withdrawals during April 2023, compared to 78 in April 2022, a 39.74% decrease.
- Conducted 16 outreach presentations, compared to 0 during April 2022.

- 43 Faculty/Staff used Free Access Week (April 24-30), compared to 12 total participants from the previous Free Access Week in 2019, a 258.33% increase.
