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- The Campus Food Pantry had 1,259 visits, compared to 116 in March 2022, a 985.35% increase.
- Received 170 referrals to the Auburn Cares office in March 2023, compared to 150 referrals during March 2022, a 12.33% increase.
- Received 40 medical withdrawal applications in March 2023, compared to 56 applications in March 2022, a 28.57% decrease.
- Processed 25 medical withdrawals during March 2023, compared to 39 in March 2022, a 35.90% decrease.
- Conducted 5 outreach presentations, compared to 2 during March 2022, a 150% increase.
- The Campus Food Pantry had 121 new users for March 2023, compared to 15 new users during March 2022, a 706.67% increase.
- Safe Harbor supported 19 survivors in March 2023, compared to 2 in March 2022, a 850% increase.
